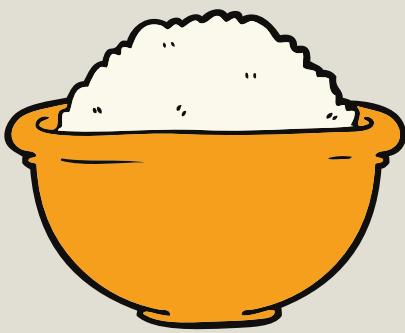




COVID-19 RESILIENCE PLAN

Our teams are working tirelessly to adapt our programs in response to the COVID-19 pandemic in Cameroon, Liberia, and Malawi so that none of our beneficiaries go without the crucial resources they need.

Continuing Food Distribution



In areas where schools are closed, our teams transitioned from serving cooked meals in school to distributing take-home rations. As schools reopen, cooking onsite is not yet allowed. Therefore, our staff trains parents on how to prepare safe lunch packs using these dry rations for their children to take with them to school.

Continuing Literacy Efforts

Our teams have scaled up our mobile library initiative to provide greater access to reading materials for out-of-school children. In areas where schools are closed, students can rent books from mobile libraries near their homes and receive one-on-one reading lessons from volunteer library managers.



Sensitizing the Community



Our teams have taken a number of steps to sensitize the communities we serve on COVID-19 infection prevention and control. In addition to hygiene training sessions, we disseminate COVID-19 prevention messages in native languages across local radio stations and mobilize community health workers to go door-to-door informing our beneficiaries on public health guidelines. To complement these efforts, we also distribute masks and sanitation products to help stop the spread of the virus.
